The Stewards, having received a report from the Clerk of the Course (doc.No. 3.9), summoned the representative of the team (STW ind.Communication No.4.4) and having examined the GPS evidence and heard the co-driver, have considered the matter and determine the following:

Fact: According to the report of the GPS System Officer Crew No.105 did not press an "OK" button on time after stopping on the stage.


Offence: Breach of Art.11.8.7 of the Supplementary Regulations of the rally


Decision: **To levy a fine of 50 EUR**
A reprimand


Reason: Art. 11.8.7 states that in case of an accident or technical problem during a Special Stage, by pressing an "OK" button a crew informs of a stop for more than 30 seconds and that immediate assistance is not required (even if a crew is trying to continue the rally).
The co-driver Jüri Lohk explained that the crew understands that they made a mistake and they apologise for this. The car had a gearbox problem and immediately after stopping, the crew started to fix the car in order to continue and being in a hurry forgot to press the button.

The fine has to be paid to the Rally HQ manager within 48 hours.


